Dear Madam,

I hereby acknowledge receipt of your communication dated 17 November 2021, by which the Association of Free Trade Unions of Slovenia (ZSSS) submitted a representation to the International Labour Organization, under article 24 of the ILO Constitution, alleging non-observance by Slovenia of the Occupational Safety and Health Convention, 1981 (No. 155).

In accordance with article 2 of the Standing Orders concerning the procedure for the examination of representations under articles 24 and 25 of the Constitution of the ILO, this representation will be submitted to the Officers of the Governing Body of the ILO, who will report to the Governing Body on its receivability at its 344th Session (March 2022). In this regard, please find attached a copy of these [Standing Orders](#).

I would like to draw your attention to the fact that, in reaching a decision concerning the receivability, the Governing Body will not enter into a discussion on the substance of the representation. Please note that, if the Governing Body declares the representation receivable, it will set up a tripartite committee in accordance with the applicable procedures.

I am also pleased to inform you that, at its 334th Session (November 2018), the Governing Body approved a number of measures concerning the functioning of the procedure for the discussion of complaints under article 24 of the Constitution. In this regard, I draw your attention to documents [GB.332/INS/5 \(Rev.\)](#), [GB.334/INS/5 Annex I](#) and [GB.334/INS/5](#), paragraph 21, subparagraph 1(a), as amended by the Governing Body. In this context, I note that your organization expressed its willingness to consider the possibility of entering into conciliation prior to the examination of the admissibility of the claim, and its wish to be assisted by the Office and the secretariat of the Workers' Group in this regard.
